As you're aware, we have been following government advice regarding school closures, and in light of this we will continue to follow their advice and make tomorrow the last day of term.

Our teaching staff have been preparing for closure by developing more capabilities to learn from home, and tomorrow will be an opportunity to consolidate that learning and give some final advice and practice so students can engage in online learning for the foreseeable future. It is crucial that students take home everything they possibly can, as it may be impossible to access the school property after tomorrow. If this isn't possible, contact the office and we will make special arrangements for you. There may be some changes to timetables tomorrow to best prepare students for their 'new normal'.

I want to thank teaching, administration and maintenance staff for being on the front line in the last few weeks, ensuring our school has been as safe and calm as possible.

We are well aware that God knows the beginning from the end, and at this time we would urge all families to lean into the peace and security that is offered from our loving God as we navigate this crisis.
