



## COVID-19 Update 29

17 February 2021

Dear Parents/Guardians,

The premier made his announcement early today which indicates that there is considerable confidence about the decision. I am pleased that we are going back to almost all the conditions before our “circuit breaker” lockdown.

### All students back

That means all students are back at school on Thursday, 18 February. Students over 12 years of age will be required to wear a mask inside and outside where they are not able to distance 1.5 m from each other. Students over 12 should bring a mask to school. If students have a medical exemption from wearing a mask, then the college should have an asthma plan or a letter from a doctor giving that exemption recorded on Seqta.

### Who should not attend?

The college takes a cautious approach to possible infections for the protection of our students and staff.

- If a student or staff member is displaying symptoms of COVID-19, they should not attend the college until they are tested and cleared by DHHS. Hayfever symptoms do not apply if we have a medical letter on file confirming this.
- If a member of a household has been instructed to isolate, then no members of that household should attend the college until DHHS has cleared the potential infection.

### Canteen Reminder
