

Arrowsmith Program Options 2020

Over the last 4 years, the Arrowsmith program at PVCC has seen student growth and academic progress in all participating students. In consultation with Arrowsmith Canada, in 2019 PVCC opened up more flexible options for students to engage with the Arrowsmith program. All programs will take place during school hours.

The one program option would involve one period per day of Arrowsmith classes, two program option would be two periods per day in the Arrowsmith classroom etc.

Note: The one program and part time program options do not replace normal learning support programs within the school. Learning support for full time Arrowsmith students will be determined on a case by case basis.
