

Arrowsmith Program 2024

The Arrowsmith program at PVCC has seen student growth and academic progress in all participating students since its inception in 2016.

Who is the Arrowsmith program for?

Rather than accommodating to or working around a fixed learning profile, through applying the principles of neuroplasticity, Arrowsmith's cognitive programs strengthen and enhance each learner's fundamental cognitive capacities which underlie all aspects of learning.

Students are enrolled in the Arrowsmith program for a vast array of reasons. A typical student may experience difficulties in some of the following areas or simply want to strengthen specific areas including:

- reading
- mathematics
- logical reasoning
- auditory memory
- non-verbal learning
- working memory
- writing
- comprehension
- visual memory
- dyslexia
- auditory processing
- processing speed

All program options listed below will typically take place during school hours. There is an option of after school and some tasks can be undertaken online.

The 'One program' option would involve an average of one period per day of Arrowsmith classes, the 'Two programs' option would be two periods per day in the Arrowsmith classroom etc.

Arrowsmith Program Options

Cost in addition to school fees

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| ● Full Arrowsmith program assessment | \$2,200 |
| <i>(\$1,100 credited back to fees if enrolled in the program within 90 days)</i> | |
| ● Each program (1 period per day) | \$3,000 |
| ● Two programs (2 periods per day) | \$6,000 |
| ● Three programs (2 periods per day + homework) | \$9,000 |
| ● Four programs (4 periods per day) - full time/maximum number of periods per day | \$12,000 |

Note: The 'One Program' and part time program options above do not replace normal learning support programs within the school. Learning support for full time Arrowsmith students will be determined on a case by case basis.
